Introduction & Beginner I Class:

The Beginner I class is for students with no playing knowledge of the game of golf. Class is design to give them the basic ability to develop golf skills enabling them to advance to the next level. The class criteria are as follows:

Instruct on the Rules of Golf and Safety around the green.

Grip and stance.

Chipping drill to teach distance control.

Skill challenge.

Rules and safety at the driving range.

Grip and stance.

Work on swing short to full swing.

The class will work on these techniques until the class is able to pass all skill challenges. Once the class can pass these challenges they will move to Intermediate I class.

Intermediate I Class & Advance:

The Intermediate I class is for students with playing ability or has completed Beginners Class I. Students will be playing the par three course and working on scoring skills so they can advance to intermediate II class. The score level to obtain in this class is no more than two over par per hole. The passing score is less than 26 for five holes to be able to advance to the next level Intermediate II.

Intermediate II Class & Advance:

The Intermediate II class is for students with playing ability or has completed Intermediate I. Students will be playing the par three course, three holes on the Professional course and working on scoring skills so they can advance to intermediate III class. The score level to obtain in this class is no more than two over par per hole. The passing score is less than 18 fur three holes on the Professional course to be able to advance to the next level Intermediate III.

Intermediate III Class & Advance:

The Intermediate III class is for students with playing ability or has completed Intermediate II. Students will be playing the Professional course and working on scoring skills so they can advance to making any golf team. The score level to obtain in this class is no more than three over par. The passing score is less than 4 over for the total number of holes played on the Professional course to be able to graduate.
